



ATTACHMENT A - ANTI DOPING 2009

Some medication for Asthma, ADHD and other ailments are on the World Anti-Doping Agency "**Prohibited List**".

If you are a **COMPETITIVE Level Member** of Skate Australia you are required to notify Skate Australia of the Medications and dosage you are taking. If you are or have ever taken medication for Asthma, ADHD or Diabetes please complete the information below.

If you are a **COMPETITIVE Level Member** and are taking other medications and are unsure whether it is on the "**Prohibited List**" you should also complete the information so that the medication can be verified by Skate Australia's Sports Medicine Commission.

If you already have a current Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) or ATUE and have changed your medication since your last approval you should also complete the information so that our records can be updated and your new medication can be verified by Skate Australia's Sports Medicine Commission.

Remember it is up to you whether you notify or not, however, if you choose not to provide the information requested and you are asked to undergo a Drug Test (either in or out of competition) you could record a positive test.
